SEPULVEDA TRANSIT CORRIDOR PROJECT (STCP)

In 2017, Metro began this project without contacting our community first It goes from the Westside through the Pass then through Sherman Oaks

One of Metro's route options, called **ALTERNATIVE 4**, has big noisy trains running ~30 feet above Sepulveda Blvd for 5 miles – In only the Valley – Not on the Westside

SOHA HAS WORKED SINCE 2018 TO STOP ALTERNATIVE 4 METRO WON'T LISTEN




Metro just released the Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) for the project

GIANT TUNNEL AND EMINENT DOMAIN ON DEL GADO DRIVE

Metro will bore 5-mile-long, 43-foot-diameter tunnel for Alternative 4 – **as big as a 4-story building** – Starting at Del Gado Drive and boring south to UCLA campus



NOISY CONSTRUCTION WILL TAKE 5+ YEARS

Construction at Sepulveda and Valley Vista
Tunnel boring typically 24 hours a day
1 million dump trucks of debris removed
Significant and unavoidable construction
noise from at least Saugus Ave to
at least Sherman Oaks Ave
